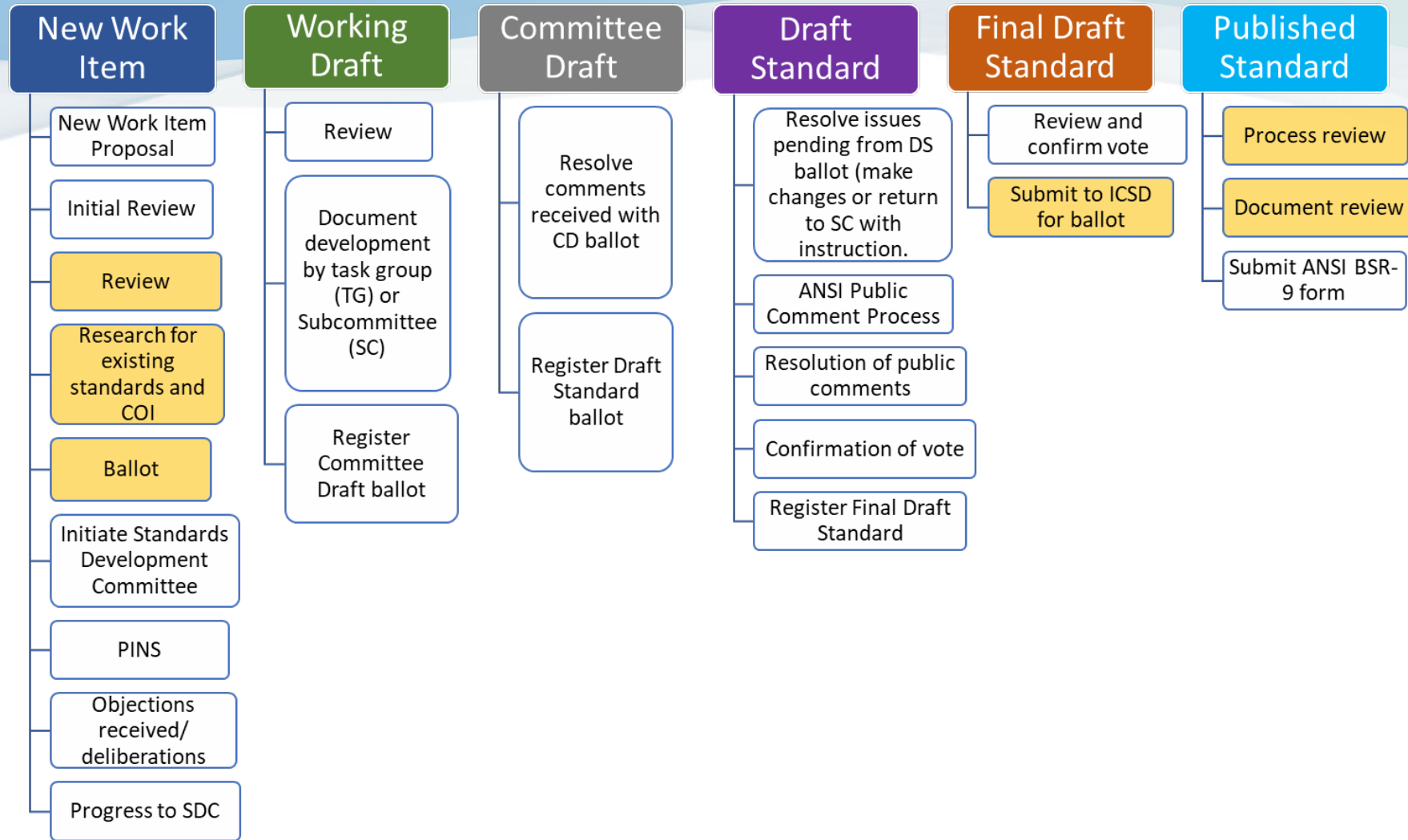

Research Subcommittee

- Met beginning June 7, 2022
- Reviewed current trends and considerations in CE/T including:
 - Skill-based training in a remote world
 - DEI trends
 - Hybrid learning trends
 - Training in the metaverse
 - Micro-learning trends
- Suggested most of these trends be monitored for future consideration in CE/T Standard
- Suggested micro-learning be considered immediately, specifically for CEU recognition
- Suggested the construction of a survey to better understand global DEI trends

Draft Development Subcommittee

- Met beginning June 13, 2022 to perform Initial Revision and development of Draft Standard.
- Draft Standard was submitted for Public Comment
- Held a series of meetings from 8/14 – 8/28/2023 to consider and incorporate public comments into the Final Draft Standard.
- Final Draft Standard was submitted for SDC vote/approval

Open Discussion

- Document this experience; Codify best practices and procedures
 - Use in onboarding
 - Introduce Standards Administrator sooner; Chair and Admin cooperation was critical
 - Research Subcommittee should meet sooner – further in advance than Draft development
 - Draft subcommittee should be around 6 members
 - Commission representation is valuable (2 on draft sub)
 - Outline diversity of membership (stakeholder representation); who needs to be at the table?
